



### What will I need?

- \* 250g Plain Flour
- \* 125g of table salt & 125g of water
- A Large bowl and spoon
- \* Paint, paint brushes, and any materials you wish to decorate your pot



1. Set the oven on it's lowest setting , line a baking tray with parchment and measure out your ingredients. Mix the flour, salt and water together in your bowl until it forms a ball of dough. Flour your work surface.



2. Transfer to a floured work surface. Hold the ball of dough with one hand and use your other thumb to press into the centre of the ball. Press until your thumb is about half a cm from the bottom. Widen the hole by pinching up the walls, turning slowly for event thickness, ensuring the walls and bottom are at least 0.5cm thick, then flatten the bottom so the pot stands up.



3. Embellish with other features such as a handle (simply moisten and pat it in to place), or carved detail such as lines, dots or grooves. Bake for 3 hours or until solid. Allow to dry before painting and adding other decoration to make your pot look fabulous!
