### You Will Need:

**A deep muffin tin, flour, strainer, bowl, spoon, paper, water**

Soak the paper, pulp into a paste, then strain the water out. Next, add a bit of flour to the paper until you get a doughy consistency. Put the mixture into your muffin tin to form a bowl shape. Let it dry and you'll have your very own pots to decorate any way you wish.
