



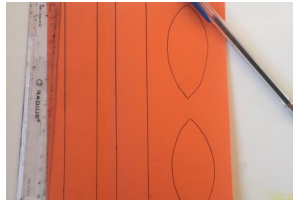
These bright and cheerful Easter Chicks are lots of fun to make

What will I need?

- * A paper plate, yellow paint, crayon or felt tip, some orange paper or card
- * A glue stick or PVA glue, googly eyes or a black felt tip to draw eyes
- * String, ribbon or wool (if you have craft feathers you can use these for wings)
- * Split pins (just use glue instead if you don't have these)



1. Colour or paint your paper plate yellow and allow to dry. Thread string through a hole at the top to hang it by



2. Draw 2 long legs with feet on the end, a beak and 2 wing shapes on the orange paper and cut them out.

3. Accordion-fold the legs and glue them to the bottom of the plate, then use split pins to attach the wings, and draw or stick on the beak and eyes
